**REPORT OF WATER CONSERVATION**

**Over the years rising populations, growing industrialization and expanding agriculture have pushed up the demand for water.**

**Effects have been made to collect water by building dams reservoirs and digging wells.**

**Some countries have also tried to recycle and desalinate sea water.**

**Water conservation has become the need of the day.**





## 1. ORIENTATION OF AREA BASED PROJECT

Students were briefed about their second area based project. All related activities were also planned out during this interactive session.

## 2. REUTILISATION OF USED GARAGE WATER

First wash garage water is not reusable for plants. But second wash water can be reused. Garage workers near college premises were made aware about water conservation. They were convinced to water newly planted trees and to reutilize his second wash water.



### 3. ESSAY WRITING

Essay writing competition was conducted for students to spread message of water conservation and theme was “*Water – Save and Recycle Me.*”

### 4. POSTER MAKING

Students made posters on the theme - ***save water***. They flaunted their skills by making apt posters and writing catchy slogans. These posters were used in rally by making placards out of it.



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## 6. GRAM SARVEKSHAN

Student volunteers had done survey in adopted areas. They carried a questionnaire with them. Students also explained concept of reduce, reuse and recycle to people in village.





## 7. AWARENESS PROGRAMME FOR SCHOOL STUDENT

NSS volunteers arranged programme for school and junior college students for giving the information about water saving. In this programme NSS had given information about problem arises in our country because of water scarcity. Hence we have to reduce the use of water and conserve the water.

## 8. RALLY FOLLOWED BY SIGNATURE CAMPAIGN

NSS student organised a rally in adopted area. Volunteers participated in the rally displaying placards on the importance of saving water for future generation.

- Hazards of water waste were explained using posters.
- Rally of students to spread the awareness about water conservation.
- After rally a signature campaign was conducted to reduce wastage of water.



## 9. VILLAGE SURVEY ON WATER CONSERVATION

Students firstly explained importance of water to all villagers. They also collected information through survey regarding water utilization of each household and water conservation measures followed by them.

## 10. STREET PLAY

Skit promoting awareness of conservation of water was rendered by NSS volunteers to educate students and villagers. Large quantity of water is being wasted for washing clothes and source of water is also contaminated. Consequences of water wastage were also explained.



## 9. AWARENESS ON RAIN WATER HARVESTING

NSS students organised a rally in adopted area.

- Rainwater is the only source of drinking water in Konkan region due to ample rainfall it receives every year.
- This rainwater needs to be harvested for utilising it for the entire year.
- This water can be retrieved using bore wells and hand pumps.
- Nearby Villagers were made aware about entire water cycle and pros and cons of rain water harvesting.
