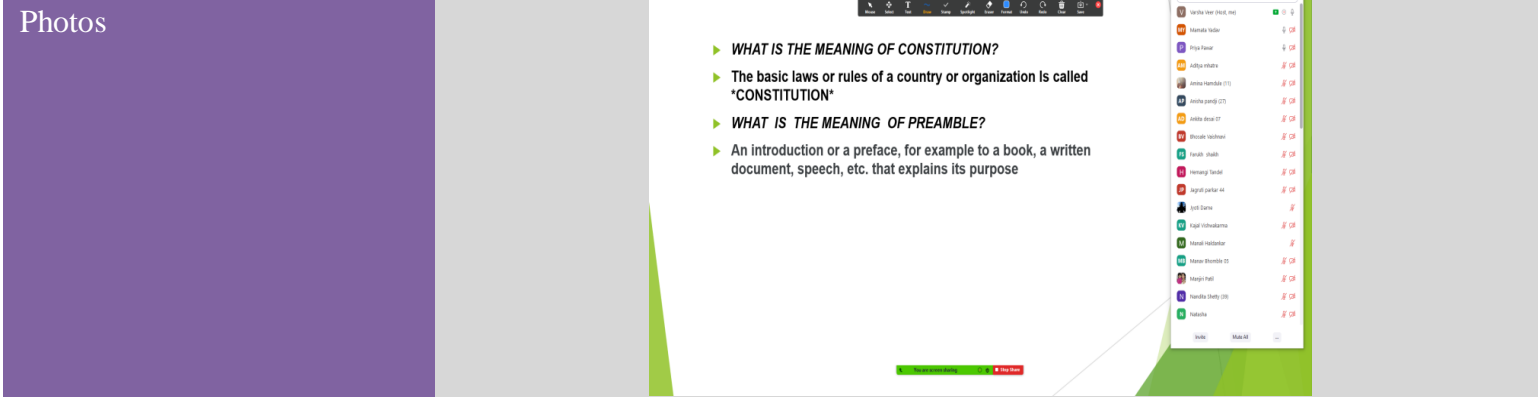

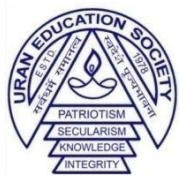

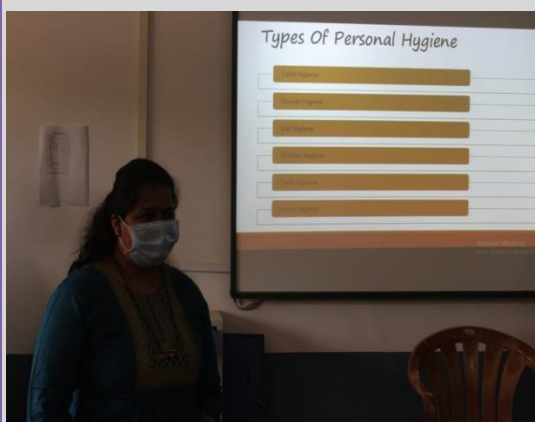

Name of the Event	Student's Survey on the topic Pandemic situation
Brief Report of the event	<p>NSS Students conducted a survey of the college students on the topic Pandemic Situation.</p> <p>Several questions were asked to study the situation of students during Pandemic.</p> <p>Number of responses – 60</p> <p>Students were asked about college's response to the students during pandemic and 90% students were satisfied with the response of the college during crisis.</p> <p>More than 50% of the students think Covid 19 crisis does impacted their ability to study or learn.</p> <p>25% of the students have started attending lectures online for learning more and more during such unprecedented situation.</p> <p>For improvement of class, students feel that the lectures should be conducted offline. Some says that the attendance should be strict and other says that the teaching should be in funny way.</p> <p>More than 25% of the students feels the challenging aspect of online learning is Network issues. Other says that understanding the lessons in online lectures is the most challenging thing.</p> <p>Students expects that keeping video chats, asking frequent questions, using easy language may help to improve the virtual classroom experience, where some says that no improvement is needed.</p> <p>60% of the students wants to attend lectures physically where other 40% students are okay with virtual learning.</p> <p>When the students were asked what they do miss about attending classes physically, students said that they miss their teachers, friends, group studies, college activities and practical sessions.</p> <p>15% students feel that distance learning made them more excited about the studies where 25% said it made them less excited and the students who fees that there is no change ranging above 11%</p> <p>More than 50% of the students feels that the grading scale should be adjusting for the students engaging is virtual learning.</p>


