A. Collaborate to enhance work in the areas of B. Com. by faculty exchange policies.

 6. To permit students, staff and faculty members to in the library facility, if needed
- Amendments/modifications This MoU may be amended or modified by a written agreement signed by the preventatives of both institutes.

Participating faculties, and students involved in any activities under this memorandum must adhere to the law of the host institutions and their rules and regulations.

Legal Effect

Nothing in this Memorandum shall be construed as creating any legal relationship between the institutes. This Memorandum is a statement of intent to foster genuine and mutually beneficial collaboration. In case, there is a dispute relating to any aspect of academic cooperation, the parties will jointly resolve the dispute in a spirit of independence, mutual respect, and shared responsibility.

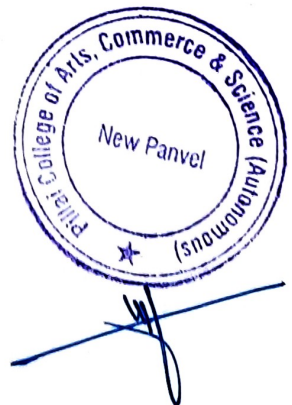

Areas of agreement: -

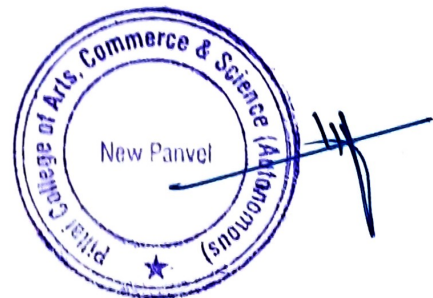
